Dear colleagues,

Since my last update at the April 8 FAC meeting, we were scheduled for two bargaining sessions with FPC: one on Tuesday, April 15 (2 – 3:30 p.m.) and one yesterday, Thursday, April 24 (2 – 5 p.m.).

The April 15 session focused entirely on counterproposals.

The April 24 session was intended to address new proposals, including, among other areas, FAC proposals on key financial items such as salary, health insurance, and retirement. The FAC Table Team prioritized bringing these financial topics to the table ahead of our final FAC meeting of the academic year, scheduled for Thursday, May 8.

Regrettably, FPC had to cancel the session yesterday as neither their lead nor a designate was available. With limited time remaining in the academic year, we are awaiting a response from FPC to reschedule for

next Thursday, May 1.
